This program is 5 days a week program. After the first semester all students required to take the CNA Exam and can obtain that licensure. This program is a mix of book work, and clinical experiences, which provides a very hands-on learning environment. At the end of the 12 month program, the students prepare for the NCLEX licensure exam, which is scheduled for after graduation. In addition, the clinical experience gives students an opportunity to get familiar with local hospitals, and build a rapport with the staff. This helps the students get know the various business

and industry personnel that can hire them when they graduate.
